

## Example of wording regarding the transfer of conditions in “L2a1 AGREEMENT on the transfer of Human Biological Material to a Research Principal” to Third Party.

An agreement “L2a1 AGREEMENT on the transfer of Human Biological Material to a Research Principal” is established between the principal of the biobank and the research principal.

The example text below can be used to transfer the conditions in the agreement to Third party. The text only relates to the transfer and handling of material that Third party shall receive.

**Please note**, that the university may have produced a more extensive agreement (e.g. including conditions for publishing) that shall be established with the one called Third Party in the MTA, and where the transfer of conditions in MTA is included. Always coordinate with the university’s legal department before establishing an agreement.

### Parties

This Agreement on the transfer of human biological materials (“Agreement”) is signed between the \_\_\_\_\_ (Research Principal), and the recipient of samples \_\_\_\_\_ (Recipient), each a “Party” and collectively hereafter referred to as the “Parties”

The Parties hereby agree as follows:

### 1. Governing Agreement & General Conditions

- 1.1 The parties agree that the conditions in the Material Transfer Agreement, “L2a1. AGREEMENT on the transfer of Human Biological Material to a Research principal” (including any appendices), signed between the Research Principal and the Swedish biobank, shall be the governing conditions (“Governing Conditions”) of this Agreement.
- 1.2 The Governing Conditions, and therein specified conditions and obligations, shall, with appropriate changes, be in force between the parties of this Agreement.
- 1.3 The Governing Conditions shall be attached to this Agreement.
